GENERAL OVERVIEW

You can choose to:



Prepare for the eclipse, explore your natural surroundings, and **OVERNIGHT IN THE BUSH** before witnessing the eclipse the next morning.

That night, after the eclipse, you will resume luxury at the Angsana for a gala celebration dinner. The tour is designed with enough time to learn about the Australian Outback and experience the eclipse, relax and enjoy the ambiance of Palm Cove.

You are thrilled to have Fred Watson accompany this exciting programme to North Queensland to view the solar eclipse. He led us to Peru to view an ancient Incan observatory and to Europe to trace the history of the telescope (as narrated in his book "[STARGAZER, the LIFE and TIMES of the TELESCOPE](#)"). Recently He was Astronomer/Scientist on MV ORION trip that took us from DARWIN to BROOME.

Fred Watson is **Astronomer-in-Charge of the Anglo-Australian Observatory**, operating Australia's largest optical telescope (the 3.9m Anglo-Australian Telescope), and is Project Manager for the International RAVE Radial Velocity Survey of a Million Stars at Siding Springs near Coonabarabran in NSW, Australia.

He has several sessions on ABC radio each week, is a regular contributor to Australian Geographic and has a busy speaking schedule.

Fred is a well-known author on subjects astronomical and his enthusiasm and love of his subject will enhance your eclipse experience.

Exclusive Outback Site

Outback Queensland is the perfect venue for the Australian Eclipse. The region is seeped with history. In the 1870s tens of thousands of miners flocked to this area searching for gold leading to the establishment of the ports of **Cairns, Cooktown and Port Douglas**.

Palmer River, about 270 kilometres north-west of Palm Cove, has remnants of one of north Queensland's most famous **gold mining towns**. An estimated *20,000 Eclipsers* will be heading to the solitary Palmer River Roadhouse, just north of our site and will be perched on the hill or along the Peninsular Development Road. Our site is private and entry is by special permission of the owner of Maitland Downs. (*pictured right*) This area has been noted as one of the best viewing sites for the eclipse with the path uninterrupted from east to west.



Maitland Downs Cattle Station has the charm of the Australian outback, commanding views over one of **Australia's** most **remote vistas** and is **included in the tour package prices**. However, if you prefer, you may choose to experience the Australian Eclipse from the comfort of the Angsana Resort and Spa.

The choice is yours, but either way, you'll have the best vantage points for the **Australian Eclipse 2012**.

7 day Itinerary

Day 1

- Friday 9th November 2012

- *Palm Cove*

Arrive at Cairns Airport for a brief but important visit to the **Royal Flying Doctors** supporting the excellent work this service offers. You will then be transferred to the **Angsana Reef Resort and Spa in Palm Cove**.

Cooktown ** Numbers strictly limited

Cooktown has over two centuries of rich history. Captain James Cook landed there in 1770. There was a massive gold rush in the 1870's. Explore Cooktown's history and culture, walk through town, and visit the museums and monuments after a couple of hours drive along one of Australia's most scenic coastal drives, through the World Heritage listed Daintree National Park. After lunch (included) at the Lions Den, continue to the unique geological oddity, Black Mountain, which is surrounded in mystery and spoken of in ancient Aboriginal legend.

9 Holes Golf

Enjoy the lush rainforest environment of Palm Cove whilst playing 9 holes at the Novotel Rockford Resort. Your excursion includes return transfers to the course nearby and a 2 Course lunch.

You may even like to give scuba-diving a go for the first time or make the most of your diving licence. Bird life too is diverse and bountiful.

After a full day on the water, **snorkelling**, and a **Gourmet Seafood Buffet Lunch**, cruise back to Cairns with time for more questions for Fred Watson about the eclipse. Our coach will return us to the Angsana.

Red Desert Tours will have the campsite ready for our arrival at Maitland Downs. You will depart early from the Angsana Hotel armed with telescopes and personal supplies for a trip through the Atherton Tablelands.

When there, the time is yours to enjoy the tranquillity of the bush setting, participate in some activity or prepare for the following early morning. Your **exclusive** bushcamp site permits perfect viewing of the eclipse as well as the

approaching shadow. (**subject to weather conditions*) There are commanding views of the cattle station and the Daintree Mountain scape featuring plentiful birdlife. Maitland Downs may not have electricity, but what it lacks in facilities, is made up for in outback splendour.

This experience is one that will stay with you for long after the event itself.

Red Desert was formed in 2001 by **Anthony (Macca) and Karen McDonald**. The business represents a life long dream for these two adventurers who escaped corporate life to spend as much of their time as possible "getting dirty" in the bush.

As a team Macca and Karen have a unique blend of skills that ensure that eclipsers will be able to fully concentrate on your unique expedition while all of the details required for a successful journey are taken care of seamlessly in the background. For this reason they have been chosen by Australian Geographic to support many of their outback journeys to remote corners of Australia.

Whilst the Outback Adventure is included in the tour package, you are at liberty to stay at the Angsana Resort to view the eclipse. You will have plenty of time to plan a location for your telescope, relax around the pool and read the paper.

Restaurants in Palm Cove

Palm Cove is abounding with some of the finest restaurants in all of Tropical North Queensland. Take a stroll along the beachfront at Palm Cove any night and you'll smell the aromas wafting from fine dining restaurants. The choice is dazzling. Thai, French, Italian and contemporary Australian food: Palm Cove is a diner's delight.
